- **Grab-and-Go Lunches for children** - West Shore School District is offering bagged lunches for children starting March 17th between the times of 11:00 am to 1:00 pm due to the COVID-19 shutdowns. This meal is available to children 18 years and younger who meet federal guidelines. The children must be present to receive the bagged meal.

- **Sheetz** -Kidz Meal Bagz is a program providing free meals to help children and families in need as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.
