

**CAMP HILL SCHOOL DISTRICT**

**RESOLUTION NO. 22 - 3**

**WHEREAS**, the Camp Hill School Board is responsible for Camp Hill School District (CHSD) policies regarding the health and safety of its students and staff, including masking and other mitigation efforts in our schools related to COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the responsibility of the Camp Hill School Board to review and adjust its policies in this regard as appropriate, taking into account emerging data regarding COVID-19 case counts as well as testing and vaccine availability, and in particular the availability of vaccines to those ages five and older since October 29, 2021.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of School Directors of the Camp Hill School District, as follows:

Section 1. As of March 15, 2022, mask use will be optional for students, staff and visitors at each of the CHSD schools, district office, and other CHSD facilities.

Section 2. The CHSD will maintain its internal COVID Tracker on a school-specific basis.

Section 3. Active case data will be assessed each Friday, and updated counts will be communicated to parents, students, staff, and the community at large.


Section 4. Should the active case count rise to a level of concern, a special meeting of the Board will be held to reassess this policy.


Section 5. This policy becomes effective immediately.
