Dear Parents/Guardians and Students,

We have very exciting news to share with all of you! At the February 10, 2020 School Board meeting, the Directors approved moving forward with the final phase of the renovations at the Middle/High School. The renovations are extensive and in order to complete the majority of the project prior to the start of the 2020-21 school year, work will begin this Monday, February 24. Contractors and sub-contractors will begin a 10-hour shift at 3:30 pm, after students and staff have left for the day. This “2nd shift” will enable us to adhere to the established construction schedule, complete several renovations before the summer, and will not impact students and staff during the instructional day.

Although no construction will be taking place during the day, all contractors and sub-contractors are required to submit updated clearances to the District. Additionally, our spaces will be transitioning into a more “industrial” look. We are asking for your patience and understanding during this time of transition. When you make your way around the Middle/High School in the coming months, you should be prepared for the following:

- Removal of corridor and classrooms ceiling tile and grids
- Removal of corridor and classroom flooring and grinding of floors
- Removal of classroom unit ventilators
- Installation of new classroom flooring
- Addition of two new classroom spaces in a portion of the current media center
- Renovation of bathrooms
- Repairs and renovations in the gymnasium
- Renovations to the art room

We have been working hand in hand with our construction management partner, SitelogiQ, to ensure that staff and student safety continues to be the highest priority and that our spaces will be cleaned and usable before the start of each school day. As the renovations begin, we will provide additional updates as needed. Stay tuned for a quick link on the District’s homepage where we will display a gallery of “before and after” photos showing our progress. We are ready to navigate this short-term inconvenience for long-term, positive gains.
