Required daily for in-person Latin class:

- **✓** Pencil with eraser
 - o no pens are needed
- **✓** 3-subject spiral notebook
- **✓** CHSD-issued Chromebook
 - o charged and ready to use
- **✓** Headphones
- **✓** Willingness to learn and grow

You are required to use **pencil** in this class. I expect mistakes to occur and that is okay. Pencils and erasers allow for you to correct any errors as we go over homework in class. The key to overall success is to make corrections and learn from them.

All Camp Hill students have Chromebooks issued by CHSD. Please bring your device charged and ready to use. Headphones are also useful for some activities. Please don't distract yourself or others with any electronics during class.

In relation to the use of technology in the classroom, <u>no pictures are allowed of anyone</u> (including Magister Kreider) during class time without permission of that person as well as Magister. This includes moving pictures (aka videos) and Zoom sessions. This CHSD policy as well.

The textbooks, like the Chromebooks, are owned by the school. Please take care of them and bring to class daily. If you destroy or lose a textbook, you will have to pay for a replacement. If you do not bring your book to class, you will lose participation points.

It will also be important to have a <u>3-subject spiral notebook</u>. One section for grammar notes, another for culture notes, and a last section for your written work. Please make sure that you have a way to store printed sheets, like quizzes and study guides. Many notebooks come with pockets. An additional pocket folder may be useful if those pockets are insufficient.
