REGISTRATION FOR THE 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR

Online pre-registration to register students for the 2023-24 school year (for all grades) will open on April 26, 2023. Please visit the Camp Hill School District's website on or after this date to complete the online registration form. Please contact the Registrar at the District Administration Office if you are unable to complete the online registration form. Students entering Kindergarten must be 5 years of age by September 1, 2023 to be eligible to start school.
